



Network

- Combination of local neighborhood streets and arterial streets
- Linkages to the larger regional network

Traffic Patterns

- Primary commuter routes (E Capitol, Southern, Minnesota, and Massachusetts)
- Some arterial streets carry vehicles traveling both through (cut-through) and to the neighborhoods

Safety

- Cameras have been placed strategically to address problems with speeding
- Speed humps have been installed on certain neighborhood streets as a traffic calming measure
