



GOAL

The overarching goal of the Far Southeast III Livability Study is to promote safe travel for residents of and visitors to the study area, and to improve the operational efficiency of the transportation network for all modes of travel.

SAFETY

Roadway design, traffic calming (where appropriate), intersection improvements, and signal timing adjustments.

ACCESSIBILITY

Enhanced pedestrian crossings, accessible paths and bus stops, and signage upgrades.

MOBILITY

Alternative transit routes, expanded walking and biking opportunities, and new transportation options.

GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE

Improve access to existing green spaces, attractive streetscapes, and stormwater management.

HEALTH

Increased opportunities for active transportation, promote access to healthy food, and address traffic-related safety concerns.
